This Acceptable Use Policy ("AUP") sets rules for using BreezeNodes services, including VPS, dedicated servers, GPU servers, game servers, related panels, and network resources. It forms part of our Terms of Service. By placing an order on BreezeNodes, the customer accepts these terms and this AUP.

1. Purpose

BreezeNodes provides hosting infrastructure for IT enthusiasts and customers who need affordable, reliable servers. You must use services lawfully, respect others, and avoid harm to our network, hardware, customers, or third parties.

2. Prohibited Activities

The customer is not allowed to:

- Host, distribute, or facilitate illegal content, including CSAM or sexual content involving minors (real or synthetic), exploitation, trafficking, terrorism, fraud, phishing kits, stolen credentials, or other content illegal under UK law or other applicable jurisdictions.
- Run hacking tools, malware, ransomware, botnets, C2 servers, unauthorized scanning, exploitation, credential stuffing, or brute-force attacks against third parties.
- Crypto mine on a VPS (or other plans where mining is prohibited).
- Send DoS or DDoS attacks, run reflection/amplification or flood tools, operate open proxies/resolvers, spoof IPs, or otherwise abuse the network.
- Send unsolicited bulk email or messaging (spam), mail bombing, list scraping, or unauthorized SMTP relay.
- Host piracy, unauthorized cracks, warez, DRM circumvention, trademark impersonation, or counterfeit distribution.
- Attempt to escape isolation, attack BreezeNodes systems, access other customers' data, deliberately overload shared nodes beyond fair use, or resell services in breach of product terms.
- Use game hosting (when offered) for unrelated high-risk workloads such as attack tooling or bulletproof hosting.

3. Content Monitoring

We do not routinely monitor Customer Content on your server. We may investigate when we receive complaints, detect abuse signals, or receive legal notices, and may access logs or content as needed to enforce this AUP, protect the platform, or comply with UK law (including a valid warrant or court order).

4. Enforcement

Breezenodes Ltd has the right to suspend or terminate a service or account if there is any form of prohibited or illegal activity. Depending on severity, we may:

- Warn and request remediation
- Throttle, null-route, or filter traffic
- Suspend the service or account
- Terminate without refund once provisioned (consistent with our Terms; subject to mandatory law)
- Preserve data and cooperate with law enforcement where required

We may act immediately for CSAM, active attacks, imminent harm, or clear illegal activity.

5. Appeals

If you believe enforcement was in error, reply to the notice or open a ticket within fourteen (14) days with relevant evidence. We will review in good faith. Repeat or egregious violations may be denied re-entry.

6. Copyright / Takedown Notices

Send copyright notices to **legal@breezenodes.com** with your contact details and signature, a description of the work and allegedly infringing material (URLs, IPs, or paths), and a statement of good-faith belief and accuracy. Where permitted by law, counter-notices may be submitted. We may remove or disable access to allegedly infringing material.
